Hurricane-force winds brought torrential rain that triggered floods and mudslides that flattened whole towns across Northern Mindanao. The deluge left a quarter million people without shelter, food, water, and clothing. Means of livelihood were destroyed. Death toll was 600 and counting, and hundreds more missing.

Typhoon victims' immediate needs are food, water, medicine, clothing, blankets, and toiletries. They also need to rebuild their homes and school buildings.
